(daclatasvir)

## What is Daklinza™?

- Daklinza™ is a prescription medication used for the treatment of hepatitis C virus in combination with another medication called sofosbuvir (Sovaldi™).

## How should I take Daklinza™?

- Take 1 tablet of Daklinza™ with 1 tablet of sofosbuvir (Sovaldi™) once a day for 12 weeks.
- You may take this medication with or without food.

Once a day for 12 weeks

## What should I do if I miss a dose of Daklinza™?

- If you forget to take a dose of Daklinza™, take your dose as soon as you remember on the same day. If you remember to take your dose the next day, skip the missed dose and take your next dose as scheduled. Never take 2 tablets of Daklinza at the same time.



## Are there any side effects from Daklinza™?

When Daklinza™ is taken in combination with sofosbuvir (Sovaldi™), the most common side effects are headache and tiredness.

### Helpful Tips to Manage Side Effects:

- Drink plenty of water
- Try to take 20-minute naps to increase your energy
- Do important chores in the morning, when you have the most energy



## What else should I know about Daklinza™?

- **Do not start any new medications,** over-the-counter medications, vitamins, or herbal supplements without speaking to your healthcare team.
- It is important to have your blood tested during your treatment as instructed by your doctor.
