

Kings Specialty Pharmacy Guide to Medication Storage

Drug	Storage
Cetrotide 0.25mg	 In Refrigerator; Protect from light; Once dissolved, use immediately and discarded any unused medication
Crinone	 At Room Temperature
Endometrin	 At Room Temperature
Follistim AQ Cartridge	 In Refrigerator until expiration <u>OR</u> at Room Temperature for up to 3 months; Protect from light; Once rubber inlay has been pierced with needle, store for a maximum of 28 days in Refrigerator <u>OR</u> at Room Temperature
Ganirelix	 At Room Temperature; Protect from light
Gonal-F Multi-Dose	 At Room Temperature; Protect from light; Once dissolved, store in Refrigerator <u>OR</u> at Room Temperature for up to 28 days
Gonal-F RFF	 At Room Temperature <u>OR</u> in Refrigerator; Protect from light; Once dissolved, use immediately and discarded any unused medication
Gonal-F RFF Pen	 In Refrigerator until expiration <u>OR</u> at Room Temperature for 3 months; Protect from light; After first use, store in in Refrigerator <u>OR</u> Room Temperature for up to 28 days
Leuprolide Acetate 2-Week Kit	 At Room Temperature; Protect from light; Once vial is punctured, store at room temperature for up to 14 days
Leuprolide Microdose	 Expires 14 days after compounding (check date) Refrigerate; Protect from light
Leuprolide Trigger	 Expires 14 days after compounding (check date) Refrigerate; Protect from light
Menopur	 At Room Temperature <u>OR</u> in Refrigerator; Protect from light; Once dissolved, use immediately and discarded any unused medication
Novarel	 At Room Temperature; Protect from light; Once dissolved, store in Refrigerator for up to 30 days
Novarel Diluted	 In Refrigerator for up to 14 days; Protect from light
Ovidrel Microdose	 In refrigerator for up to 14 days; Protect from light
Ovidrel PFS	 In Refrigerator until expiration <u>OR</u> at Room Temperature for up to 30 days; Protect from light
Progesterone in Olive Oil Compounded	 Store at room temperature; Expiration date on vial Once rubber seal is punctured, expires in 28 days
